 The Prime Tower has its own rapid-transit railway station, almost at the front door – Hardbrücke – with trains running at 3- to 5-minute intervals. Zurich main station for Intercity and main-line connections is just 2 minutes away, whilst the airport can be reached in 12 minutes. The motorway is nearby providing a direct link to the A1 and the West Tangent for north- and southbound traffic.

 Together with the Cubus and Diagonal annexes the Prime Tower forms a complex that includes a staff restaurant, lifestyle lounge, gourmet palace, studios, salesrooms and event centres. In addition to the Prime Tower, other investors are planning to build hundreds of new apartments. These will be surrounded by parks and lawns, shops and restaurants.
